

Dividers, Hangings and Clothes

Starting Points

Gather found objects such as sand, soil, leaves, petals, fluff and paper etc. Arrange in patterns on small squares of translucent cover with same size piece of translucent so trapping the pattern inside. Either sew or rivet squares together.

Small groups of children could be given a certain theme or colour to work with.

Other Possibilities

Using netting and sew and build up pattern with found objects. Old section of garden trellis, one square for each child to make a design. Cloaks could be made using the same method. These are worn in some parts of Polynesia.
